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HOW TO PREPARE FOR UGC NET

If you are interested in pursuing a career in academics and have a Master's degree with at least 55% marks, you are eligible to write the UGC NET (National Eligibility Test) exam. You need to crack this exam to teach as a lecturer in a college or university or to win a Junior Research Fellowship (JRF).

These days, the National Testing Agency (NTA) conducts the UGC NET exam on behalf of the University Grants Commission (UGC).

The good news is that now one can also use your UGC NET scores to get lucrative jobs in PSUs (public sector undertakings). These include plum posts in the fields of management, finance, human resources, corporate communications and research & development (R&D).

This year, the NTA will conduct the NET exam from June 20 to 28, 2019.

Eligibility Criteria for UGC NET Exam

The General Category



students need 55% marks in their Master's degree while students of the reserved categories will need 50% marks to be eligible for the exam. PhD degree holders, who did their Master's before September 19, 1992, are allowed a relaxation of 5% marks in the qualifying criteria.

Do note that students from Economically Weaker Section

(EWS) category are also eligible for 10% reservation in this exam.

Students aiming for the JRF scholarships should not be more than 28 years of age on January 1 of the year of examination. It means that if you are appearing for the UGC NET 2019 exam, you should not be more than 28 years of age on January 1, 2019.

Reserved category students are allowed relaxation of five

years in the qualifying age for the exam. Candidates with research experience in the relevant field (related to their subject in post graduation) may be allowed a relaxation of five years on producing a certificate from the relevant authority. LL.M degree holders are allowed a relaxation of three years in the maximum age limit for the exam.

There is no age limit specified for students who want to become Assistant Professors through the exam.

UGC NET Exam Pattern

The NTA UGC NET is exam is conducted in the CBT mode, which means it is a computer-based test.

The duration of the exam is for three hours. Earlier, the exam used to have a 30-minute break between Paper I and Paper II but in June 2019, the paper will be conducted in a single session.

• The Paper I tests the candidates' General Awareness and contains 50 questions worth 100 marks.

You will get one hour to solve this paper.

• The Paper II contains questions related to the subject chosen by the candidates. It contains 100 questions worth 200 marks. You will get two hours to solve Paper II.

You can move freely between the different sections of the exam - allowing you greater freedom to manage your time in your own way.

All the questions in Paper I and Paper II are objective-type and multiple-choice questions (MCQs). Overall, you will have to solve 150 questions in the exam which are worth 300 marks. It is mandatory to answer all the questions in the exam.

One can write the exam in either English or Hindi. You can opt for more than 84 subjects for the UGC NET exam but it is recommended to opt for the subject directly related to your

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CAREERS IN THE FINANCIAL WORLD

In a survey at management education institutions, it was found that specialization in finance is available at maximum number of institutes and it also is the most sought after specialization. This can be interpreted as a matter of demand and supply.

All business organizations need a number of resources and finance is one such prime resource. In fact finance touches most aspects of a business organization. Even for individuals and families the importance of finances can't be overemphasized. Our budget is about finances for the nation. Thus the world of finance permeates us all. Business performance to a larger extent depends on management of finances and all medium and large organizations require specialists to manage their finances.

Finances have major implication for firms. It requires



detailed study of the subject to understand all such implications. As such the subject has been developed as a major area of study. In wake of increasing collaboration between countries of the world and liberal trade practices, the subject has assumed greater significance. Every business organization tries to maximize profits and enhance shareholders' value. The world of business is becoming competitive day by day. In order to first survive and then keep ahead in such competition it becomes a

must to make prudent use of all the resources including financial resources. Finance professionals are thus in great demand everywhere and myriad career opportunities are available for them.

In order to make a proper career in finance one or more of the following qualifications will be required-

Master of Business Administration with specialization in Finance: A postgraduate degree in management expressed as M.B.A or M.M.S, is most sought

after by young people now days. A full time course takes two years to complete while for a part time course one needs 3 years. In the course candidates are required to choose one or more specializations. Choosing finance as your specialization gives you the opportunity to explore opportunities in this subject.

Masters of Financial Management: Some management institutes conduct a course with this nomenclature which is largely similar to doing the above course.

Master of Commerce: Post graduation in commerce is another avenue to enter the realm of finance. Although accountancy covers a major part of commerce, it is seen as a plus point and many firms prefer to employ M.Com degree holders for their accounts and finance function.

Chartered Accountancy: It is a highly specialized course and can be undertaken after completing 10+2 level. Option to

pursue chartered accountancy with Bachelor of Commerce is also available. This course is divided in two parts of Inter and Final followed by practical training in form of articleship. More details about this course can be obtained from the official website of Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.

Post-graduation in Economics: Study of Economics opens many doors of career opportunities. A career in finance is also possible with this degree. With specialization in econometrics or statistics your chances of laying your hands on such a career will be more. Independent course of Post-graduation in Statistics are also available.

Cost & Works Accountancy: On the lines of chartered accountancy this course also has been developed. Institute of Cost & Works Accountants of India has its comprehensive website offering relevant details of the course.

So there are multiple entry qualifications to make a career in finance. If we see the current trend, of the above most financial careers go to MBAs with specialization in finance, simply because their availability is more. This is followed by students qualified in chartered accountancy who are comparatively short in supply.

Subjects of study in Finance

Finance has a wider coverage. The topics of study include- Business analysis and valuation, security analysis, portfolio management, risk, project appraisal, balance sheet analysis, investment banking, international financial management, quantitative analysis for business decisions, security valuation, private equity, global/ emerging financial markets, behavioural finance, mergers and

acquisitions, hedge funds derivatives etc.

If you're interested in any particular area of finance you should check the specialization and electives before finally choosing a course.

Functions of a finance professional

The job of finance professional includes formulating organization's overall financial strategy in consultation of the top management, forecasting profits and losses, exploring sources of finance on best terms, preparing financial statements and annual performance reports, coordinating with internal and external auditors, ensuring compliance with legal requirements and regulations etc. These are only some areas of work.

Where to study

Some of the well known institutions offering valuable course in and related to finance, include Indian Institute of Management, Ahmedabad (and at other centres) Sriram College of Commerce, New Delhi

Jamnalal Bajaj Institute of Management Studies, Mumbai S P Jain Institute of Management Research, Mumbai

This can be a long list, so only few names are given.

Career opportunities

Public sector or private sector, manufacturing or service organizations; finance professionals are needed everywhere. In fact as told earlier, of all the specializations in postgraduate management programmes finance specialization has maximum number of students in most of the institutions.

A career in finance should be chosen if you have the required aptitude. If you're good with numbers, ratios and calculations and love complexities, finance may be an appropriate choice for you.

Many of the selections for finance profile are done through campus placements at major management institutions.

Multinational companies, foreign and new age private banks fulfil their requirement of junior finance professionals through campus selection.

Leading public sector organizations viz. National Thermal Power Corporation, Oil & Natural Gas Commission, Hindustan Petroleum Corporation, Bharat Petroleum Corporation, Indian Oil Corporation, Oil India Limited, Gas Authority of India, Steel Authority of India, Hindustan Aeronautics Limited, Powergrid Corporation, Petronet LNG etc. recruit management trainees in finance and some other disciplines every year. Finance professional can enter banks (both public and private sector) as general banking officers. They are also taken as specialist officers for credit, corporate and infrastructure finance etc. Insurance companies in both public and private sector have regular requirement for finance professionals. Considering the size of organizations like Life Insurance Corporation, General Insurance Corporation, National Insurance Company and Oriental Fire & General Insurance have more opportunities. Most of the states have state finance corporations managed by finance professional. Even Industrial Development /Finance Corporations require the services of finance professionals. Many corporate houses have non-banking financial arm as an independent venture e.g. PTC India Financial Services. There are infrastructure development finance companies like IDFC. Another big segment is of housing finance companies like Canfin Homes, PNB Housing Finance, LIC Housing Finance, GIC Housing Finance etc. In all such organizations obviously the maximum ratio is of finance professionals.

Mutual fund industry is on a growth path in our country. Mutual funds mobilize funds from individuals and corporates to invest in stocks, debts and other financial instruments. So the basic job of a mutual fund is to ensure maximum return with least risk. Two major profiles available in mutual fund companies are that of fund manager and equity analyst. While fund managers have the overall responsibilities of managing funds mobilized under particular schemes, equity analysts profile companies and shares which are expected to generate maximum return. Which stocks to buy or sell, and when is what they do on regular basis. Even stock broking companies have requirements of equity analysts and researchers.

Another niche career in finance can be explored with credit rating agencies. All

companies which want to mobilize deposits, equity and loans have to get their credit rating done by identified rating agencies. CRISIL, ICRA and CARE are leading credit rating agencies of our country. There are also global agencies like Standard & Poor's.

Finance professionals have challenging opportunities with merchant bankers, investment bankers and domestic as well as Foreign Institutional Investors (FIIs). Such entities are usually considered better pay masters. Off course the job role also has higher expectations. Opportunities exist in pension funds, national and global audit firms as well.

Software development companies also need financial specialists as domain experts. Those interested in journalism and have a background in finance or economics may prefer to work with media houses. The career of a financial journalist can be considered in newspapers, business magazines or TV channels. Another career is of a financial planner or consultant.

Many engineers prefer to go for MBA (Finance) after their graduation. They are considered more suited to work in the domain of industrial finance. Another popular combination with finance is that of a degree in law. It is a matter of personal choice to go for additional degrees or certifications but any of the courses mentioned in the beginning of this article is considered to be sufficient for a finance career.

Those with an academic orientation may choose to teach finance at colleges, universities, management and other training institutes. This teaching job can be undertaken as a fresher or after having some work experience. A doctoral degree is becoming an essential requirement for teaching higher classes. You may join a Fellow Programme in Management (equivalent to doctorate) at one of the IIMs. Doctoral courses in management are extensively available at universities and other management institutes like XLRI etc.

Career growth

In the long term under corporate careers, a qualified and hardworking professional may reach to the position of Chief Financial Officer (CFO) of a small, medium or large organization. NOTE (i) Candidates seeking age relaxation are required to submit copies of necessary certificate(s) at the time of joining, if qualified. No change in the category of any candidate is permitted after registration of online application. No correspondence/email/phone will be entertained in this regard.

(ii) CUMULATIVE AGE RELAXATION WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE EITHER UNDER THE ABOVE ITEMS OR IN COMBINATION WITH ANY OTHER ITEMS.

2. RESERVATION FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITY (PWD):

4% horizontal reservation has been provided to Persons with Benchmark Disabilities as per section 34 of “Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016”. The post is identified suitable for the Persons with undernoted categories of disabilities as defined in the Schedule of RPWD Act 2016:

- A. Locomotor Disabilities (LD):** A person's inability to execute distinctive activities associated with movement of self and objects resulting from affliction of musculoskeletal or nervous system or both, including Cerebral Palsy, Leprosy Cured, Dwarfism, Muscular Dystrophy and Acid Attack Victims. Orthopedically challenged persons are covered under locomotor disability with following bench mark:
- OA - One arm affected (Right or Left)
 - OL - One leg affected (Right or Left)
 - OAL - One arm & One Leg affected
 - BL - Both legs affected but not arms

Persons with OA and OAL category should have normal bilateral hand functions.

- a. **"Leprosy cured person"** means a person who has been cured of leprosy but is suffering from:
- Loss of sensation in hands or feet as well as loss of sensation and paresis in the eye and eye-lid but with no manifest deformity;
 - Manifest deformity and paresis but having sufficient mobility in their hands and feet to enable them to engage in normal economic activity;
 - Extreme physical deformity as well as advanced age which prevents him/ her from undertaking any gainful occupation, and the expression "leprosy cured" shall be construed accordingly;
- b. **"Cerebral palsy"** means a Group of non-progressive neurological conditions affecting body movements and muscle coordination, caused by damage to one or more specific areas of the brain, usually occurring before, during or shortly after birth;
- c. **"Dwarfism"** means a medical or genetic condition resulting in an adult height of 4 feet 10 inches (147 centimetres) or less;
- d. **"Muscular dystrophy"** means a group of hereditary genetic muscle disease that weakens the muscles that move the human body and persons with multiple dystrophy have incorrect and missing information in their genes, which prevents them from making the proteins they need for healthy muscles. It is characterised by progressive skeletal muscle weakness, defects in muscle proteins, and the death of muscle cells and tissue;
- e. **"Acid attack victims"** means a person disfigured due to violent assaults by throwing of acid or similar corrosive substance.
- B. Visual Impairment (VI):** Only those Visually Impaired (VI) persons who suffer from any one of the following conditions, after best correction, are eligible to apply.
- a. **Blindness:**
- Total absence of sight; OR
 - Visual acuity less than 3/60 or less than 10/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with best possible correction; OR
 - Limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of less than 10 degrees. OR
- b. **Low Vision:**
- Visual acuity not exceeding 6/18 or less than 20/60 up to 3/60 or up to 10/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with best possible corrections; OR
 - Limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of less than 40 degrees up to 10 degrees.
- C. Hearing Impaired (HI):**
- a. Deaf: means person having 70 DB hearing loss in speech frequencies in both ears.
- b. Hard of Hearing: means person having 60 DB to 70 DB hearing loss in speech frequencies in both ears.
- D. 'd' & 'e':** Only those persons, who suffer from any one of the following types of disabilities, are eligible to apply under this category:
- a. **"Specific Learning Disability" (SLD)** means a heterogeneous group of conditions wherein there is a deficit in processing language, spoken or written, that may manifest itself as a difficulty to comprehend, speak, read, write, spell, or to do mathematical calculations and includes such conditions as perceptual disabilities, dyslexia, dysgraphia, dyscalculia, dyspraxia and developmental aphasia.
- b. **"Mental Illness" (MI)** means a substantial disorder of thinking, mood, perception, orientation or memory that grossly impairs judgment, behaviour, capacity to recognise reality or ability to meet the ordinary demands of life, but does not include retardation which is a condition of arrested or incomplete development of mind of a person, specially characterised by subnormality of intelligence.
- c. **"Autism spectrum disorder" (ASD)** means a neuro-developmental condition typically appearing in the first three years of life that significantly affects a person's ability to communicate, understand relationships and relate to others, and is frequently associated with unusual or stereotypical rituals or behaviours.
- d. **"Multiple Disabilities"** means multiple disabilities amongst LD, VI, HI, SLD, MI & ASD.

Note: Only "person with bench mark disability" would be eligible for

reservation with not less than 40% of a specified disability where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and includes a person with disability where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the certifying authority.

A person who wants to avail the benefit of reservation will have to submit a latest Disability Certificate, on prescribed format, issued by Medical Authority or any other notified Competent Authority (Certifying Authority) in the District of the applicant's residence as mentioned in the proof of residence in the application. The certificate should be dated on or before last date of registration of application.

Use of Scribe & compensatory time:

The facility of scribe would be allowed to a person who has disability of 40% or more if so desired by the person and is meant for only those persons with disability who have physical limitation to write including that of speed. In all such cases where a scribe is used, the following rules will apply:

- Candidates eligible for and who wish to use the services of scribe in the examination should carefully indicate the same in the online application form.
- Both the candidate and the scribe will have to give a suitable undertaking, in the prescribed format with passport size photograph of the scribe at the time of online examination.
- Such candidates who are eligible to use a scribe shall be eligible for compensatory time of 20 minutes for every hour of the examination whether availing the facility of scribe or not.
- Candidate will have to arrange his/ her/ their own scribe at his/ her/ their own cost.
- Any candidate who is not eligible to use scribe as per guidelines, as referred above, uses scribe in the online examination shall be disqualified to participate further in the recruitment process.
- Any candidate who is using scribe should ensure that he is eligible to use scribe in the examination as per the guidelines mentioned above.
- Any candidate using scribe in violation of the above guidelines shall stand disqualified and can be removed from service without notice, if already joined the Bank.
- Scribe will be allowed to be used as per the guidelines issued vide Office Memorandum F.No.16-110/2003-DDIII dated February 26, 2013 of Government of India, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Department of Disability Affairs, New Delhi and clarification issued by Government of India, Ministry of Financial, Deptt. of Financial Services vide letter No. F. No. 3/2/2013-Welfare dated 26.04.2013.

3. EX-SERVICEMEN

Only those candidates shall be treated as Ex-Servicemen who fulfil the revised definition as laid down in Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms Notification No.36034/5/85/ Estt (SCT) dated 27th October, 1986 as amended from time to time.

Disabled Ex-Servicemen: Ex-Servicemen who while serving in Armed Forces of the Union were disabled during war or in peace time but their disability being attributable to Military service, shall be treated as Disabled Ex-Servicemen.

Dependents of Servicemen killed in Action: Servicemen killed in the following operations would be deemed to have been killed in action attributable to Military Service (a) war (b) warlike operations or border skirmishes either with Pakistan on cease fire line or any other country (c) Fighting against armed hostiles in a counter insurgency environment, viz. Nagaland, Mizoram, etc. (d) Serving with peace-keeping mission abroad (e) Laying or clearance of mines including enemy mines as also mine sweeping operation between one month before and three months after conclusion of an operation (f) Frost-bite during actual operations or during the period specified by the Government (g) Dealing with agitating Para-Military forces personnel (h) IPKF personnel killed during the operations in Sri Lanka. The reservation available to such candidates shall be as mentioned under point no. (b) given under the vacancy table.

For the purpose of this reservation, the members of the family would include his widow, son and daughter or near relations who agree to support his family. The relaxation in upper age and educational qualifications available to Ex-servicemen will not be available to dependents of Servicemen killed in action.

NOTE: 1) (i) Candidates, who are released/retired from Armed Forces, are required to submit a certificate as per Proforma 'A' attached to this advertisement if they do not possess discharge certificate/booklet, (ii) The candidates, who are still serving in Armed Forces and desirous of applying under Ex-Servicemen category will be required to submit a certificate (Proforma 'B') from the competent authority showing his/her date of completion of the specific period of engagement (SPE) along with declaration (Proforma 'C'). Such

candidates whose SPE is completed on or before 30.04.2020 only are eligible to apply under this recruitment. They will also be required to submit the release letter along with a self-declaration at the time of joining the Bank that he/she is entitled to the benefits admissible to Ex-Servicemen in terms of Govt. of India rules, (iii) Those candidates, who have already completed their initial period of engagement and are on extended assignment, are required to submit certificate as per Proforma 'D'. If selected, such candidates mentioned in (ii) and (iii) above, should get released and join the Bank on or before 30.06.2020. These certificates are required to be submitted at the time of joining invariably. 2) The Territorial Army Personnel will be treated as Ex-Servicemen w.e.f. 15.11.1986.

3) An Ex-Serviceman who has once joined a Government job on the civil side after availing of the benefits given to him as an Ex-Serviceman for his reemployment, his Ex-Serviceman status will be governed in terms of OM No.36034/1/2014-Estt.(Res.) dated 14.08.2014 of Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions.

4. SELECTION PROCEDURE: The selection process will consist of online test (preliminary & main examination) and test of specified opted local language.

Phase-I: Preliminary Examination: Preliminary Examination (online) consisting of Objective Tests for 100 marks will be conducted online. This test would be of 1 hour duration consisting of 3 Sections as follows:

There will be negative marks for wrong answers in the Objective tests. 1/4th of mark assigned for question will be deducted for each wrong answer.

No minimum qualifying marks for individual subject as well as for aggregate (overall) are prescribed.

Adequate number of candidates in each category as decided by the Bank (approximately 10 times the numbers of vacancies, subject to availability) will be shortlisted for the Main Examination from the list of all candidates arranged in descending order of aggregate marks scored.

Each test will have a separate timing as mentioned above.

The questions in objective tests, except for the test of General English, will be bilingual, i.e., English & Hindi. There will be negative marks for wrong answers in the Objective tests. 1/4th of mark assigned for question will be deducted for each wrong answer.

Candidates are required to score a minimum percentage marks on aggregate (For SC/ST/OBC/PWD/XS candidates, 5% relaxation available thereon). Minimum qualifying marks on aggregate will be decided by the bank. No minimum qualifying marks for individual subject are prescribed. Merit list will be drawn State wise, category wise. Candidates qualified in the test (main examination) will be placed according to their aggregate marks in descending order in respective States and Categories.

NOTE: Other detailed information regarding the examination will be given in the 'Acquaint Yourself' booklet, which will be made available to the eligible candidates along with the call letter for the test.

Test of specified opted local language:

Those who qualify for selection and produce 10th or 12th standard mark sheet/ certificate evidencing having studied the specified opted

local language will not be subjected to any Language test. In case of others (qualified for selection), specified opted local language test will be conducted after provisional selection but before joining. Candidates not found to be proficient in specified opted local language would be disqualified.

Provisional Selection (Subject to qualifying specified opted local language).

The marks obtained in the Preliminary Examination (Phase-I) will not be added for the selection and only the aggregate marks obtained in Main Examination (Phase-II) will be considered for preparation of the final merit list. Provisional selection will be made on the basis of candidate's performance in the test (main examination).

Final selection: will be subject to:-

- Verification of eligibility for the post and information furnished in the online application.

Results of the candidates who have provisionally qualified for selection will be made available on the Bank's website.

Wait List:

A wait list of up to 50% of vacancies (State-category wise) will be maintained. Candidates will be released from this wait list on quarterly basis against non-joining and resignation out of the current batch only, subject to the candidates securing minimum qualifying marks as may be stipulated by the Bank for selection. 7. EMOLUMENTS

The total starting emoluments of a Clerical Cadre employee payable at Metro like Mumbai will be around ₹25,000/- per month inclusive of D.A., other allowances at the current rate and **two additional increments for newly recruited graduate junior associates.** Allowances may vary depending upon the place of posting. They will be eligible for reimbursement of various perquisites, provident fund, Pension under New Pension scheme (Defined Contribution Benefit), Medical, Leave fare and other facilities, as per instructions of the Bank as may be issued from time to time.

11 HOW TO APPLY

Candidates can apply online and no other mode of application will be accepted

(a) GUIDELINES FOR FILLING ONLINE APPLICATION:

Candidates will be required to register themselves online through Bank's website <https://bank.sbi/careers> or <https://www.sbi.co.in/careers> - Recruitment of Junior Associates 2019. After registration candidates are required to pay the requisite application fee through online mode by using debit card/credit card/Internet Banking.

Helpdesk: In case of any problem in filling up the form, payment of fee/ intimation charges or receipt of Admission/call letter, queries may be made at telephone no. 022-22820427 (between 11:00 AM and 06:00 PM on working days) or lodge his/her query on <http://cgrs.ibps.in>. Candidates are advised not to forget to mention 'Recruitment of Junior Associate-2019' in the subject of the email.

Pre-requisites for Applying Online: Candidates should have valid email ID and mobile no. which should be kept active till the declaration of results. It will help him/her in getting call letter/advice etc. by email/SMS.

(b) PAYMENT OF FEES: [ONLINE MODE ONLY]:

- Candidates should first scan their photograph and signature as detailed under guidelines for scanning the photograph and signature (Annexure-II).
- Candidates to visit Bank's website <https://bank.sbi/careers> or <https://www.sbi.co.in/careers> and open the appropriate Online Application Form, available in the 'Current Openings'.
- Fill the application carefully. Once the application is filled in completely, candidates should submit the data. In the event of candidates not being able to fill the data in one go, they can save the data already entered. When the data is saved, a provisional registration number and password will be generated by the system and displayed on the screen. Candidates should note down the registration number and password. They can re-open the saved data using registration number and password and edit the particulars, if needed. This facility will be available three times only. Once the application is filled in completely, candidates should submit the data. No change/edit will be allowed thereafter. The registration at this stage is provisional.

13. PROOF OF IDENTITY TO BE SUBMITTED AT THE TIME OF EXAMINATION:

The candidates must bring one photo identity proof such as passport/Aadhaar/PAN Card/Driving Licence/Voter's Card/Bank Passbook with duly attested Photograph/Identity Card issued by School or College/Gazetted Officer in the official letterhead in original as well as a self-attested Photocopy thereof. The photocopy of Identity proof should be submitted along with call letter to the invigilators in the examination hall, failing which or if identity of candidates is in doubt the candidate will not be permitted to appear for the test.

14 BIOMETRIC VERIFICATION: The Bank, at various stages, may capture thumb impression of the candidates in digital format for biometric verification of genuineness of the candidates. Candidate will ensure that correct thumb impression is captured at various stages and any inconsistency will lead to rejection of the candidature. In case of any candidate found to be not genuine, apart from taking legal actions against him/her, his/her candidature will be cancelled. As such, they are advised not to apply any external matter like mehendi, ink, chemical, etc. on their hands.

15. ACTION AGAINST CANDIDATES FOUND GUILTY OF MISCONDUCT:

- Candidates are cautioned that they should not furnish any particulars that are false, tampered/fabricated and they should not suppress any material information while filling up the application form.
- At the time of examination, if a candidate is (or has been) found guilty of: (i) using unfair means during the examination or (ii) impersonating or procuring impersonation by any person or (iii) misbehaving in the examination hall or (iv) resorting to any irregular or improper means in connection with his/her candidature for selection or (v) obtaining support for his/her candidature by any unfair means, such a candidate may, in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, will also be liable:
 - to be disqualified from the examination for which he/she is a candidate
 - to be debarred, either permanently or for a specified period, from any examination or recruitment conducted by Bank.
- The Bank would be analyzing the responses of a candidate with other appeared candidates to detect patterns of similarity. On the basis of such an analysis, if it is found that the responses have been shared and scores obtained are not genuine/valid, the Bank reserves the right to cancel his/ her candidature.

- (ii) Candidates are advised in their own interest not to bring any of the banned items including mobile phones/pagers etc. to the venue of the examination, as arrangement for safekeeping cannot be assured.
- (iii) Candidates are not permitted to use or have in possession of calculators in examination premises.

16. GENERAL INFORMATION:

- i) Candidates are advised to take a printout of their system generated online application form after submitting the application.
- ii) Candidates should satisfy themselves about their eligibility for the post applied for. The Bank would admit to the test all the candidates applying for the post with the requisite fee on the basis of the information furnished in the online application and shall determine their eligibility only at the time of joining. Admission to tests will be purely provisional without verification of age/qualification/category (SC/ST/OBC/EWS/XS/DXS) etc. of the candidates with reference to documents.
- iii) Candidates are advised in their own interest to apply online well before the closing date and not to wait till the last date to avoid the possibility of disconnection/inability/failure to log on to the website on account of heavy load on internet or website jam.
- iv) SBI does not assume any responsibility for the candidates not being able to submit their applications within the last date on account of aforesaid reasons or for any other reason beyond the control of SBI.
- v) Not more than one application should be submitted by a candidate. In case of multiple applications, only the last valid (completed) application will be retained and the application fee/intimation charges paid for the other registrations will stand forfeited. Multiple attendance/appearance by a candidate in examination will be summarily rejected/candidature cancelled.
- vi) The possibility for occurrence of some problems in the administration of the examination cannot be ruled out completely, which may impact test delivery and/or result from being generated. postgraduate degree or closest to it.

There is no negative marking in the exam. Hence, if you do not know an answer, it is best to make an educated guess instead of skipping the question.

Smart Preparation Tips for the UGC NET Exam

- ◆ The Paper I of the exam is designed to test your general awareness, comprehension, reasoning ability and divergent thinking ability. Many guides are available in the market to help you practice questions asked in this paper. For Paper II, you should revise the syllabus of your Bachelors and Masters course thoroughly.
- ◆ The three basics always work in every exam - read through the syllabus carefully, make your own notes, and solve the previous years' papers. The process helps you remember things better and for a longer period.
- ◆ In fact, we highly recommend you to solve the five previous years' UGC NET Paper 1 question papers before you start your preparation. It will help you see that you can solve almost half the paper without studying. This will boost your confidence and help you see how many questions in the exam are easy and how many of them are difficult. Once you become familiar with the paper pattern, it will become easier for you to crack similar questions in the future.
- ◆ When you solve the previous years' papers, you might want to write down all the questions related to a topic in one place. This will give you an idea about what types of questions are asked on each topic. This will also help you make crisp and clear revision notes that are relevant for the UGC NET exam.
- ◆ You must also note down the silly mistakes every time you solve a question paper. This will help you avoid them next time you solve a paper.
- ◆ Ideally, it takes 3 to 6 months to prepare for the UGC NET exam (depending on how many hours you can devote to studies every day). So, do not procrastinate until the eleventh hour.
- ◆ It takes about 3-5 hours of regular studies to clear the UGC NET exam. You cannot skip the daily revisions if you really want to clear the exam.
- ◆ Make a study plan. Start with the topics you can cover

quickly and then, proceed to the more time-taking and difficult topics. As soon as you finish a topic, mark it as 'done' in your syllabus.

- ◆ The quickest way to learn something is to teach someone. So, offer free or paid tuitions to some students in your subject. This will help you grasp its fundamentals better.
 - ◆ Try to pick up the tricks and formulae to arrive at an answer in the shortest possible time. Time-saving tips can make a lot of difference in your NET scores.
 - ◆ Approximately five questions are asked from each topic mentioned in the Paper I syllabus, which includes:
 - ◆ Teaching Aptitude
 - ◆ Research Aptitude
 - ◆ Reading Comprehension
 - ◆ Communication
 - ◆ Reasoning (including Math)
 - ◆ Logical Reasoning
 - ◆ Data Interpretation
 - ◆ Information & Communication Technology (ICT)
 - ◆ People & Environment
 - ◆ Higher Education System: Governance, Polity & Administration
- Each of these topics carries 10 marks. So, focus on all of them equally.
- The MCQs asked in this paper can be of matching type, true/false type or assertion-reasoning type.
- ◆ Some of the easiest sections in Paper 1 are Communication, Information Technology, Reading Comprehension, and Teaching Aptitude. Reading Comprehension (RC) is something we have always done since school days while the Teaching Aptitude (TA) is quite generic. RC may need practice while a simple reading through TA chapters should be enough.
 - ◆ These days, most people are familiar with computers. If you have dabbled in computers since school, you shouldn't find the IT section difficult. Try to read up about the latest developments in the field from time to time.
 - ◆ As far as Communication is concerned, you might consider taking soft skill courses where you learn about how to take interviews, how to give presentations, and how to participate in group discussions.
 - ◆ Many students might have studied about how to do research while preparing dissertations or doing study projects. You also need to read about government policies and the latest summits about education, environment and other topics.
 - ◆ Mathematical Reasoning,



Logical Reasoning and Data Interpretation sections need regular practice.

- ◆ Revise the mathematics concepts covered in Class 9 and Class 10. Sets, patterns and approximation techniques are quite important.
- ◆ To improve Reading Comprehension, read about a topic and then try to summarize it in your own words.
- ◆ Diagrams and flow charts are powerful visual aids to memorize things. You may also read about other types of mnemonics you can use to remember something (such as making a parody of a song or using acronyms to remember a series).

Where to find support for UGC NET preparation?

The National Testing Agency (NTA) announced that from May 2019, its test centres will be offering free coaching services to those who want to prepare for the UGC NET exam. The move has been planned to benefit students hailing from rural or semi-urban areas.

On the official site of NTA (<https://www.nta.nic.in>), you can also take a mock test for the UGC NET exam.

Many other online and offline coaching institutes also offer a variety of UGC NET coaching packages and study material.

These days, several apps are also available on Google or Apple app stores which can help you with your UGC NET preparation for free. Many of these include solved previous year question papers and sample practice questions for you.

How to prepare for the NET exam in the Last Month?

At this stage, there must be some topics that you already know well, some which you are not so confident about and some which are still untouched. Since you have only a handful of days now, ignore the ones you haven't touched yet and focus on those you already know.

Practice questions from the previous years' papers, mock tests, or from books and magazines (for competitive exams) available in the market.

Note that Paper 1 is not the qualifying exam anymore. Even if you don't score

minimum qualifying marks in Paper 1, your Paper 2 will still get checked. Your total score will be the cumulative marks of Paper 1 and Paper 2. So, even if you don't do that well in Paper 1 but score stellar marks in Paper 2, you still have a chance to crack the exam.

Moreover, Paper 1 is quite easy and you can easily score around 60% in it without much preparation. Even if you are not good at Math or General Awareness or Current Affairs, you can still clear the UGC NET in the first attempt.

On the Day of the Exam

- ◆ Remember to carry the admit card with your passport-sized photograph affixed on it. Carry an extra passport-sized photograph to affix on the attendance sheet at the examination venue. You also have to carry your identification document (such as your Aadhaar card, ration card, passport, or bank passbook) to the exam centre.
- ◆ Do not carry anything else as there will be no arrangement for safekeeping your belongings at the test centre.
- ◆ Check your keyboard and mouse before you start your test. Any technical difficulties later will only eat away your time unnecessarily.
- ◆ Most questions are easy. Options make an MCQ difficult. Easy questions give you choices where the right answer is quite obvious while difficult questions are designed in such a way that all the options seem like a plausible answer. The good news is that about 50% questions in the UGC NET exam are easy, 30% are of the moderate difficulty level and only 20% questions are really difficult.
- ◆ Do the questions you know first and bookmark the ones you would need more time to solve. Save some time to check all your answers before the exam ends.
- ◆ If you don't know an answer, try the elimination method. In this method, you eliminate answers that are obviously wrong and then, bet on the one that you think fits best as an answer. This educated guesswork increases your chances of getting your answer right.

Cut off Marks and the Merit List

General Category students need to score 40% in the exam while the reserved category students need 35% marks to be considered for the merit list. The merit list is drawn using the aggregate marks of the two papers for the NET qualifiers. Top 6% of the candidates (in each subject and category) are considered eligible for JRF if they have not applied for the position of Assistant Professor.

If you study judiciously and regularly, it is not difficult to score 70-80% marks in the UGC NET exam. So, give it your best shot.
